We would like to send out a heartfelt thanks to all our contractors who made our 14th Annual Christmas Charity event a success. Without your generous support, this event would not be possible.

This year, between the raffle and donated gift cards, we raised \$17,500!

We were able to support a total of 17 families in the surrounding areas. Each year we use the money raised to buy clothing and gifts for the families. Along with gifts, we also supply each family with food hampers and a grocery gift card for them to buy perishable food. Again, this year food was a main priority and we did spend more on the food hampers. Many of our school contacts nominated families due to children coming to school hungry, with no lunch and sometimes wearing inadequate clothing for the weather.

Below are the Charities that also benefited this year:

- Kinettes Christmas Hamper. In addition to a large monetary donation, we purchased gifts for 11-17-year-old boys and girls as they received very few gifts for this age group.
- The Pantry – an organization that supplies home cooked meals to families in need and they also supply school lunches to approximately 200 children in need.
- Homeless Shelter
